### VILLAGE HALL

Due to the Village Hall reviewing its policies, we are now having to ticket all events held there to ensure we don't go over their maximum capacity.

### SUMMER PRODUCTION: JUNGLE BOOK

Tickets will shortly be available on ParentMail to **Key Stage 2 parents only** for the summer concert on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> July.

#### Dress Rehearsal - 1.30 pm

Tickets cost £3 and are restricted to two per family, any pre-school children attending will also require a ticket. The Key Stage 1 children will be taken across to watch this performance.

#### Evening Performance - 6pm

Tickets cost £3 and are restricted to two per family unless you are a Y6 parent when you will be able to purchase up to four tickets. Any Key Stage 1 children attending will also require a ticket. *Please do not bring any pre-school children to the evening performance.* Physical tickets will not be sent home but a list of how many tickets each parent has purchased will be checked at the door.

Refreshments will be available at both events.

### PRIZE GIVING

Parents are invited to the annual prize giving at 9.00 am on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July in the Village Hall. Although we are not charging for this event, due to village hall capacity it must be ticketed. Tickets will shortly be available on ParentMail and are limited to two per family. The WSA will also be providing refreshments.

### ROMP/BEACH DAY – Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> July

Children in Years 3 to 6 are planning to leave school at about 10.00am to walk to the beach. Children in Years R to 2 will be having their school lunch early at 11.30am before walking to the beach from about 12.00. We will all be meeting on the beach for a picnic lunch at 12.30pm, if parents of children in YR-2 still want them to have some of the picnic on the beach then that is fine.
